

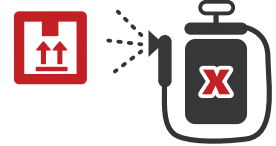
Sea Freight LCL Clearances... how does it all work?



You purchase your goods overseas
Your goods are placed inside
a container with other goods



The container is placed onboard a ship
to bring your goods to Australia



If the goods are made from
wood they need to be fumigated
prior to shipping

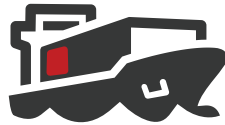

While the goods travel to Australia,
Platinum Freight[®] will be busy pre-clearing
the cargo through customs and quarantine



Once the goods arrive the
container is taken to a depot for
unpacking and separating.



Once they are unpacked you have 3
days to collect (or Platinum Freight
can have your goods delivered to you)



SCENARIO 1
Customs and Department of
Agriculture and Water
Resources release the goods.



You collect goods from the
depot OR Platinum Freight[®]
can deliver them to you



SCENARIO 2
Department of Agriculture and Water
Resources wish to inspect the goods



DAWR release the goods



You collect goods from Quarantine
depot OR Platinum Freight[®] can
deliver them to you
